

How to be a Conference Sponsor, Benefactor, or Partner

Church Sponsors

A *Church Sponsor* commits to two things. Each sponsoring church must identify one person to serve as their churches' "Mentor Father." This mentor father will commit to: praying for the fathers in his church, publicizing the conference at the church, communicating with the conference planning team, and encouraging the fathers at his church to continue to pursue becoming a father of excellence after the conference is over.

Church Sponsors will also commit to sending at least one father from their church to the conference (at least the "Mentor Father.") All sponsoring churches will have their name listed on the most recent version of the conference flier, and will be acknowledged at the conference.

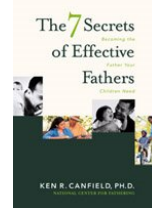
Conference Benefactors

Churches, missions, other organizations, or individuals can serve as *Conference Benefactors* at one of three levels.

1. Conference Benefactors who donate \$75.00 or more will have their name listed as a conference benefactor at the conference.
2. Conference Benefactors who donate \$100.00 will receive five free passes for the conference and will have the opportunity to send one representative to have lunch with Dr. Canfield at the conference.
3. Conference Benefactors who donate \$250.00 or more will receive ten free passes for fathers. They will have the opportunity to send one representative to have lunch with Dr. Canfield at the conference, and will receive an autographed copy of one of Dr. Canfield's books.

Conference Partner

A conference partner donates \$400.00 or more towards the cost of the conference and is recognized as a partnering host at the conference.
